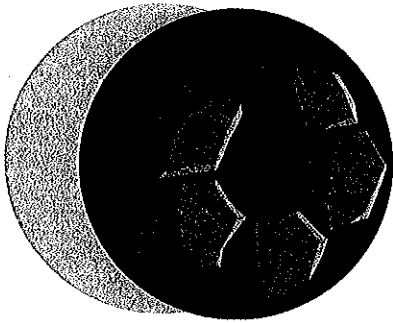
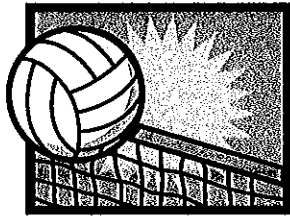

General Information

Residency

Anyone residing in the Dodgeland School District is considered a resident.
Non-resident is anyone from outside the Dodgeland School District.

Fees and Charges

The policy of the department is that those who participate in a program should help defray the overall costs of the activity. Fees and charges are therefore assessed according to the needs of the program, such as staff, equipment, umpires and maintenance. Participation in programs to Juneau residents will not be denied because of financial need. Please contact the Recreation Director for more information. **A \$5.00 late fee will be added on to anyone registering for a program after the registration deadline.**

Cancellation Of Programs

Programs held outside during the summer may be cancelled due to inclement weather. Cancellations will be determined by the Recreation Director and/or coaches. To find out about a cancellation, please tune in to WBEV 1430 AM (Beaver Dam), WXRO 95.3 (Beaver Dam), or call the recreation department.

Refund Policy

If a program is cancelled because of low registration numbers or needs to be changed do to circumstances beyond our control, a refund will be issued. Refunds will not be issued for weather cancellations or cancellations by a participant that occur within 1 week of the program start date.

Hospital/Medical Insurance

The Juneau Recreation Department does not provide medical or hospital insurance for injuries or illness a participant may sustain in a program. All individuals participating in department sponsored activities must provide their own insurance and assume the risks of all injuries.

Volunteers

Volunteers are needed to coach softball and baseball. If you can offer your time to help with these programs or any other program, please indicate this on your son/daughter's registration form.

Referees/Scorekeepers

Swim Lessons: YMCA of Dodge County

Cost: \$33.00

Limit: Unlimited
3 years and up (independent)
Class Time: 5:30 – 6:30 p.m. (45 minute class, 15 minute free time) ***NO BUS PROVIDED***

Perch – 3 years

Children start to move independently through the water without the parent. Basic skills and class adjustment are the focus of this level. Children learn to wait their turn and listen to the teacher's directions while developing their swimming skills.

- 4 years and above - Level determined by skill

Level 1 – Pike/Polliwog –

This level is designed for new swimmers. Water adjustment and independent movement in the water are developed. Children also learn basic paddle strokes and kicking skills, pool safety and proper use of instructional flotation devices and personal flotation.

Level 2 – Eel/Ray –

Children are comfortable in the water. They enhance their swimming strokes and kicks, swimming on their front and back without assistance across the pool by the end of this level. They also gain confidence in deep water by learning to tread water and beginning diving.

Level 3 – Guppy –

Children increase their endurance in all strokes while continuing to improve form and strength. Children need to swim 3 lengths of the pool and know front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke and side stroke to pass this level.

Level 4 – Minnow –

This level focuses on form and further refining the swimmers strokes learned in the previous levels. They will learn the breast stroke while continuing to increase their endurance. Children need to swim 6 lengths of the pool to pass this level.

Level 5 – Fish/Flying Fish –

Swimmers continue to work on form and perfecting basic strokes. They learn the breast stroke, butterfly, flip turns, individual medley, feet first surface dives and start dives from the block. They will increase their endurance and be able to swim 14 lengths of the pool to pass this level.

Level 6 – Shark/Porpoise–

This is the highest level for lessons, swimmers know all the strokes. Swimmers will learn rescue approach swims along with other junior Lifeguarding skills and relay starts. Swimmers need to swim 14 lengths of the pool comfortably to be in this level and will be able to swim 28 lengths of the pool to pass.

The volleyball camp is open to kids going into grades 5 - 8. The camp will cover the rules and fundamentals of volleyball. The main focus is to help the kids improve with skills like bumping, setting, spiking & overhand serving. Maximum of 20.

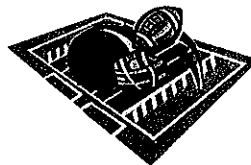
