

## Recreation Committee Meeting – March 16th, 2022

1. Meeting was called to order at 5:31 pm, and roll call was taken
2. White motioned and Wolter seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried
3. Erstad motioned and White seconded to approve minutes from February 16th, 2022. Motion carried

5. Discussion regarding the use of the Community Center for soccer practice. Motion by Smedema and seconded by White to allow soccer teams to use the Community Center to practice skills and drills. Coaches will be responsible that team members respect these parameters and team does not cause damage to the Community Center. Motion carried.
6. Ashton provided the committee with information on possible options for benches at the Wild Goose Park. The information included the materials use for the benches as well as the cost. Additional information will be needed regarding the cost of cement that will need to be laid underneath the benches. The committee will meet at the Wild Goose Park next month to determine the specific number of benches and the placement of the benches in the park.
7. General discussion regarding new signs for the City Park and Hickey Park. Ashton will gather more information regarding size, type and cost of sign options for our next meeting.
8. Discussion regarding residents vs, non-residents fees .Motion by Marose and seconded by Smedema that: Starting with summer programs, Juneau residents pay 100% of program fee and non-residents pay 150% of program fee, i.e.\$10 for a resident of the City of Juneau and \$15 for a non-resident. Motion carried.
9. General discussion regarding the mutual use of facilities between Dodgeland and the Recreation Department. Ashton will gather more information regarding the frequency, amount of time and wages expended and rental cost involved in the mutual use of facilities. Additionally, the Recreation Committee is to review the current fee schedule. This item will be placed on next month's agenda.
10. Recreation Directors report: Ashton continues to work on the summer booklet. She updated the committee on the TRP Space that will be going on the library grounds. Ashton also showed the committee the new logo for the Recreation Department.
11. Old Business: Committee would like a follow-up regarding the liner that was purchased last year but is not working as it should.
