Police Chief:

Discuss and approve Sidewalk Café Ordinance: discussion was had that the timeline should be extended until November 1st and that there was further discussion to have language in the ordinance that would restrict open flame heating devices, or any type of open flame. This ordinance will be brought back to the committee at its next regular meeting for further review before being sent onto council.
